We feel it is prudent to **further suspend service through at least April 30th** at which time the status will be reevaluated.

Additionally, **the Care Pantry distribution scheduled for April 6 is cancelled.**

We understand it is quite a hardship for some to miss our meals. If anyone is in dire need of food during this time, call the church office or Nutley Family Service (973-667-1884) and we will see that you receive food supplies. Currently Nutley Family Service is continuing its food pantry distribution with additional precautions. If they need to cancel, they will phone clients.

It is highly recommended by health officials that those who are elderly and/or with significant health conditions **remain at home.**

Steps You Can Take To Protect Yourself and Others

- Wash hands often with soap and water. If not available, use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid contact with people who are sick
- Stay home while you are sick and avoid contact with others
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing
