### **Pastor Renewal Break**

Our Bishop John Schol has recommended to all GNJ churches and the Church Council has approved a two-week Renewal Break for Rev. LeDuc after Christmas. Bishop Schol has commended our pastors for reworking everything they have known about ministry to continue bringing light and hope to our congregations and communities. Such has been true for our pastor as well. So Rev. LeDuc will be on a break from December 28 through January 10. To facilitate this, Bishop Schol and GNJ have prepared two Epiphany Services that we will share on January 3 and January 10. The Bishop will also lead small groups that week. More details below on both of these. Let us wrap Rev. Dave in prayer for a time of refreshment and renewal as he continues to serve the Lord through our Vincent Church.

### **What Is Epiphany?**

Are you acquainted with the word *epiphany*? It is derived from the Greek word *epiphaneia* and means "an appearance." Centuries ago the Church set aside January 6, the twelfth day after Christmas (hence the 12 days of Christmas!), and called that day Epiphany, to refer to the revealing of Jesus to the Wise Men who were Gentiles. The very first followers of Jesus were Jewish. The story of the revelation of Christ to the Wise Men, who were non-Jewish, is a reminder that God meant for Christ to be the Savior of the whole world. Have a Merry Epiphany!

### **"God's Epiphany In Your Life and in the World"**

Bishop John Schol of Greater New Jersey Conference will offer two engaging sermons on January 3 and 10. Week 1 – *Your Epiphany*. God is speaking to you and wants you to know the purpose and meaning God has for your life. God speaks to you as you turn outward through observing, quieting and curiosity. People will find themselves in the worship through scripture, story and sacrament. The sacrament of Holy Communion will be celebrated and worshipers are invited to bring bread and juice or water as they participate in the worship. Week 2 – *You Are the Epiphany*. God speaks through you to others. God wants you to be the voice of God through your conversations and actions. God is able to speak through us as we say 'Yay God, yes God and yahoo'. Worshipers will understand just how important they are to God and the world. The baptism of Jesus and our baptism are strong themes in the worship.

### **Notes on Sunday, January 3**

Sunday, January 3 is Epiphany Sunday, when we mark the arrival of the wise men at the manger of the Christ child. The church building will be closed for worship, but the service will be a recorded broadcast on the church Facebook page and will be available for Call In. The GNJ worship team will lead the service and our Bishop John Schol will give the sermon "Your Epiphany" and lead the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper. Join us as we begin a new year learning how God is speaking to us!

### **Notes on Sunday, January 10**

January 10 is the First Sunday after Epiphany. The church building will be closed for worship, but the service will be a recorded broadcast on the church Facebook page and will be available for Call In. The GNJ worship team will lead the service and our Bishop John Schol will give the sermon "You Are the Epiphany." Join us as we begin a new year learning how God wants to speak through us to others!


